FAA initially planned to have a fully operational cost accounting system by October 1, 1998. FAA s current schedule for full implementation of its cost accounting system for all lines of business is by the end of Fiscal Year (FY) 2002. FAA s total appropriated funds will increase from about \$8 billion in FY 1996 to about \$12 billion in FY 2001, a 50 percent increase in 5 years. Thus, a cost accounting system compliant with accounting standards is essential for FAA to control its cost growth and improve the efficiency and performance of its operations.
