Another age-related inspection protocol procedure that can affect retailer violation rates is whether minor inspectors are told to carry valid identification on inspections and required to show it when asked. The research on this issue is mixed. Some research suggests that when minors are asked to show identification, retailers are less likely to sell them tobacco products. Other research suggests, and some state officials told us, that the likelihood of an illegal sale is greater if minors show identification when asked than if identification is not shown. As a result, having and showing identification when asked could potentially result in an illegal tobacco sale and a higher retailer violation rate. About half of the illegal sales in one states inspections occurred after the minor showed 25 proof of age....
