It is unnecessary to refer to the experiments made in different countries testing the efficacy of the light, as they have uniformly resulted in its adoption. One navy after another has made practical tests, and in every case it has been shown conclusively that it would be simply impossible for a torpedo boat, in clear weather, to approach undetected a man-of-war aboard which the light was well used. Experiments at Newport show the same practical results, and although nothing has yet been done towards the introduction of the light into our service, it will become necessary as soon as our ships are built with a view to meet the requirements of modern warfare.
